Online Entry Registration Instructions

- Then go to the **COMPETITIVE EXHIBIT ENTRIES** web page.
 - click **ONLINE ENTRY REGISTRATION** button (*available starting May 1*)
- Click **Login/Logoff** and choose your **Type: Exhibitor**
 - Register using your First Name and Last Name and create a password (*write your password down or make sure it is something you will remember for future use.*) Fill in requested information, including email address. Click **Continue**.
- Click **Create Entries**. For each entry:
 - Select **Department** ex.: *Hobby Hall*
 - Select a **Division** ex.: *Woodworking, Division 202*
 - Select a **Class** ex.: *class 1580 - Furniture*
 - Fill in all requested information for the class(es) you are entering, including a brief **Description** ex: *maple chair*

WAYS TO PARTICIPATE

The Hobby Hall offers a place for amateur craftspersons, collectors and hobbyists to meet and display their crafts.

The Hobby Hall consists of four separate sections:

HANDCRAFTS ENTRIES, COLLECTIONS, DEMONSTRATIONS, and GROUP OR CLUB PARTICIPATION. There is no entry fee.

You may participate in:

A. HANDCRAFTS ENTRIES

Enter your handcrafted items.

- For all Handcrafted Entries, Divisions 200 – 232.
- Items will be judged, then displayed during the Fair.
- Please read Hobby Hall class and entry information.
- **DOLL HOUSE EXHIBITORS** please contact the Hobby Hall office, 253-841-5062 between August 1 and August 20, Mon. – Fri., 9 am to noon to register the size of your doll house. No size limit.

B. COLLECTIONS

Display and share your collection with Fair guests.

- Must be by application only. Photos of collection must accompany application.
- See information and collections application on pages 23–24 of this book.
- Collections applications are due by July 28.

C. DEMONSTRATIONS

Demonstrate your craft or hobby to Fair guests.

- Passes will be given to demonstrators.
- If interested in demonstrating your craft or hobby, contact: Marilyn Fankhauser, Hobby Hall Demonstrations, 110 9th Avenue SW, Puyallup, WA 98371 or call: 253-841-5074.
- During the Fair, craftspersons demonstrate their skills in two hours segments beginning at 11 am to 9 pm daily.

HOBBY HALL RULES

AWARDS

Each division having at least two exhibitors, if merited, will have a purple and gold Grand Champion rosette and prize awarded to the most outstanding entry of that division. A lavender and white Reserve Champion Rosette will also be given in each qualifying division. There may be one Blue (1st), one Red (2nd) and one White (3rd) ribbon given in each class. Premiums will be awarded as listed for each division and mailed mid-October. Other awards will include Honorable Mention, Merit, and Special Awards. With the exception of Trim-a-Tree Contest, only purple, lavender, blue and red ribbons will receive money or prize premiums. A peoples' choice ribbon is awarded daily in both adult and junior collections.

ABSOLUTELY NO INFORMATION ON PLACINGS OR AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN PRIOR TO FAIR'S OPENING.

DISPLAYS

All award-winning entries will be displayed, and every effort will be made to display all other entries. However, we reserve the right to withhold non-award winning entries from display. The Fair reserves the right to remove any material from any exhibit that might be objectionable. Items not displayed will be held in a secure storage area and the entrant will be called prior to the Fair opening.

JUDGING

Judges are selected from professionals or highly accredited amateur artists working within their field of expertise. Neither paid Fair employees nor volunteers are eligible to judge in the department for which they work. Paid Fair employees or volunteers who judge any show or contest outside the department they work for must be pre-approved by their department supervisor. Fair exhibitors, including exhibiting employees, are not eligible to judge in their entry divisions.

RECEIVING AND RETURN

You may drive to the Hobby Hall through the Gold Gate on 9th Ave SW, west of Meridian St. SW on entry days. Please refer to the Entry and Release Schedules on page 3 for entry and release dates and times.

HOBBY HALL HANDCRAFTS ENTRIES

The Washington State Fair Departmental Exhibitors Rules and Regulations (link on page 1) governing all departments of the Fair are to be observed with a few additions.

1. Entry registration must be made online for all divisions by entry deadline. See page 1 for online entry step-by-step instructions and page 2 for entry schedule.
2. No entry fees will be charged.

3. All articles must be the handwork of an individual exhibitor. They must be finished within the last **two years**. No article can be exhibited a second year. **SOILED OR OBVIOUSLY USED ITEMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
4. ALL ITEMS WILL BE PLACED IN THE MOST SUITABLE CLASS. Each entrant shall be limited to ONE ENTRY PER CLASS, as to enter more would in effect be competing against oneself. Entries may be reclassified by staff or judges.
5. The "OTHER" class will only be used if the item does not fit within any other class in a division.
6. All awards need not necessarily be awarded in each class at the discretion of the judge.
7. The Hobby Hall is mainly for amateur craftspersons to compete and exhibit their work. The Fair considers the following as professionals:

Anyone who makes more than \$2,000 per year from the sale of the judged craft item.

Anyone who has a certified teaching certificate for that craft.

Anyone who is paid to demonstrate that craft where supplies or finished works are sold.

Anyone who has won the Grand Champion within the last 2 years in that division.

Professional craftspersons may not enter a professional item in an amateur division.

8. Divisions for teachers and professionals are offered for Woodcarving, Decorative Arts, Calligraphy, Hand Painted China, Soft Toys & Animals, Leathercraft, Jewelry and Papercraft
9. If you have won the Grand Champion for two consecutive years in a division you will NOT BE ALLOWED to enter that division for one calendar year.
10. Junior divisions are offered in Models, Jewelry, Woodworking, Leather Craft, Scrapbooking, Paper Craft, and Ceramics.
11. All items placed on display must remain for the full length of the Fair.
12. The Washington State Fair assumes no responsibility for loss or damage. Every reasonable precaution will be used to protect items on display.
13. No "For Sale" cards will be allowed on exhibits or in the building.

Some things judges consider:

- Carving Skill:** Carving intricacy and difficulty of carving, clean cuts, surface condition, execution of details
- Finish:** Appropriateness of finish, skill and quality in finishing
- Artistry:** Perspective, form, proportion, balance, dramatic impact, and originality in interpretation of subject. Use of grain, color, knots, etc., to enhance the carving's appeal
- General Impression:** Overall effect, impact and intrinsic value

DOLLS – DIVISION 208

Please read the Washington State Fair Departmental Exhibitors Rules and Regulations, link on page 1, and Hobby Hall Rules on page 4. Exhibitors must adhere to the general rules and the specific rules below.

Entry and release dates on page 3.

Dolls in this division should resemble a human being. Animals should be entered in Soft Toys-Division 209, or Crafts-Division 217 under decorative dolls and animals, or in Division 228 Ceramics and Pottery.

Reproduction dolls have bisque (porcelain) heads and appropriate bodies. These dolls will also be judged for authenticity (that is, similarity to the doll from which the molds were made).

Modern dolls are taken from a time 25 years ago or less.
